

September 2010 was characterized by spells of indifferent weather, often windy with low overnight temperatures and extensive spells of daytime cloud. Still, a good variety of species held on into the second half of the month, albeit in relatively unremarkable numbers. Consequently, the Butterfly Transect season concluded with an Annual Index of 3326 and whilst this was well below last year's exceptional 5459 it compared very well with Indices of 3310 in 2008 and 2828 in 2007.
