



January was far from a sterile month, despite the Arctic conditions of the first two weeks. Apart from sporadic records of **Winter Moth**, a **White-shouldered House Moth** was found on the 9th and a **Light Brown Apple Moth** was disturbed from Waldershare Gully on the 11th. The onset of slightly milder conditions brought a **Mottled Umber** (a species unrecorded in 2009) on the 15th and 4 **Satellites** on the 17th. Two more Satellites were caught overnight of the 24th and we're still getting a sprinkling of Winter Moths.
